- Bob provided us with a detailed powerpoint and discussion regarding going into Spring. He discussed:
  - Checking for MITES is so important
  - $\circ$   $\;$  Feeding to stimulate and what ration is good for when
  - Requeening?? Spring or Fall
  - Walkaway spilts
  - 10 days before the apple trees bloom, you need to start looking at hives for signs of swarming and must have Drones present to swarm
  - He recommended using the Green Drone Frames, out on the outter wall of the hive. They will lay drones in there and great for mite reduction.
  - When doing a spilt, leave the queen in the original hive. Better for honey production.
  - $\circ$   $\;$  End of presentation. A few questions were asked.
